- QUALIFYING QUESTIONNAIRE -

With the exception of motor vehicle violations, since your last New Jersey Real Estate License was last issued or renewed, have you or any business in which you are or were then an owner, partner, officer or director, or member or manager of a limited liability company, been charged, indicted, convicted or pleaded "nolo contendere" to any offense, crime or, misdemeanor in the state of New Jersey, any other state or by the federal government?

a. Since your last New Jersey real estate license was issued or renewed, have you enrolled in New Jersey's pre-trial intervention program or a similar program involving the deferral of the disposition or sentencing in a criminal matter in another state or the federal government?

b. Are you currently enrolled in New Jersey's pre-trial intervention program or a similar program involving the deferral of the disposition or sentencing in a criminal matter in another state or the federal government?

Since your last New Jersey real estate license was issued or renewed, have you had a real estate or other professional license, certification or similar right to engage in real estate brokerage or any other business or profession, revoked, denied, suspended or restrained by any government authority, surrendered in lieu of formal prosecution, in this state, any other state, or by the federal government?

a. Are you the subject of an arrest warrant for failing to comply with court ordered child support obligations and/or are you in arrears on such obligations equal to or exceeding the amount of child support payable for six (6) months?

b. During the past six (6) months, have you failed to provide any court-related health care coverage?

c. Have you failed to respond to a subpoena relating to a paternity or child support proceeding?

MAKING A FALSE STATEMENT IN RESPONSE TO ANY QUESTION IN NUMBER 4 ABOVE MAY SUBJECT YOU TO CONTEMPT OF COURT.

Have you pled guilty or nolo contendere, been convicted, adjudicated delinquent, or found not guilty by reason of insanity of any sex offense that would qualify you for registration pursuant to section 2 of P.L. 1994, c. 133 (N.J.S.A. C.2C:7-2) (also known as "Megan's Law") or under an equivalent statute of another state or jurisdiction? ("Adjudicated delinquent" refers to a determination made by a family court at the conclusion of a hearing that a juvenile is found to have been delinquent based on the charges and having committed a prohibited act.)
